The 2013 Beaujolais Villages Blanc "Fleur de Chardonnay" comes from 1.25 hectares of 35-year-old vines with malolactic fermentation on the fine lees. It has a delightful bouquet with scents of lime flower and peach skin that is well-defined. The palate is clean and fresh with a spicy entry. This is a lively, energetic white Beaujolais with abundant freshness and vitality, finishing with some style, courtesy of white peach and dried apricots flavors. Drink now-2016. The 2013 Julienas Tradition comes courtesy of 5.5 hectares of 45-year-old vines. It has a slightly distant, almost aloof but rather captivating bouquet that evokes scents of black currant, briary and granite. The palate is very well-balanced with fleshy ripe red cherry and strawberry fruit. It is very focused, with good persistency, a really great Julienas to savor. Drink now-2019. The 2012 Julienas Tradition has a much more outgoing, riper nose with clean and pure red cherries and fresh strawberry mixed with Satsuma and marmalade. The palate is ripe and rounded on the entry, fleshy tannins with good depth. What it lacks in tension it compensates for with volume and corpulence on the finish. Excellent. Drink now-2018. The 2011 Julienas Cuvee Prestige comes from 85-year-old vines on quartz-rich soils, undergoing semi-carbonic maceration before being raised in vats. It has an elegant bouquet of macerated red cherries, orange peel and wild strawberry that is very defined but takes time to unfurl. The palate is well-balanced and structured, a Julienas with backbone. It feels just slightly pinched toward the finish, but bottle age should allow it to mellow. The 2013 Saint Amour "Les Capitans" comes from a single hectare of vines and undergoes semi-carbonic maceration. It has a refined bouquet of dark cherries and black plum scents interlaced with woodland aromas. The palate is well-balanced with grainy tannins. This is quite a masculine Saint Amour and yet well-balanced and fresh, finishing with gritty black currant and tart red cherries that have just that right amount of dryness to urge another sip.
